

# ~Antichrist~

Preterism acknowledges that an application, by principal, can be made that the Pope is antichristian on a grand scale, yet, clearly, not the **Antichrist** of Biblical prophecy. ### I Jn 2:18-19

- 18 Little children, it is the last time: and as ye have heard that antichrist shall come, even now are there many **antichrists**; whereby we know that it is the last time.
- 19 They went out from us, but they were not of us; for if they had been of us, they would no doubt have continued with us: but they went out, that they might be made manifest that they were not all of us.

#### I Jn 2:22

22 Who is a liar but he that denies that Jesus is the Christ? He is **antichrist**, that denies the Father and the Son.

### I Jn 4:3

3 And every spirit that confesses not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God: and this is that spirit of **antichrist**, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world.

#### II Jn 1:7

7 For many deceivers are entered into the world, who confess not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh.

This is a deceiver and an **antichrist.** 

THAT was all the times the word 'antichrist' appears in the entire Bible--4 times!
