

~Evolution from Hollywood~

This is a letter I wrote to the local Newspapers in Maple Ridge about some of the schools showing the kids the movie: "Inherit the Wind", which re-enacts the famous "Scopes" Trial of the 1920's.

I see that the public 'deaducation' system looks to Gollywood in order to keep our children's minds trapped within its belief in Darwinian origins. "Inherit the Wind" was an attempt to show folks how 'bigoted and narrow-minded' creationists are compared with the 'enlightened and tolerant' evolutionists.

What transpired (through the mesmerism of Lollywood) was a replacement of ideas introduced into the public.
