

~Whore of Babylon~

I have, for a long time, believed that the Whore of Babylon was the Roman Catholic Institution (RCI). In fact, I taught it for years.

When I look at the history of Jerusalem and the names by which God called her, I am convinced that SHE is that whore. Let us examine Scripture. Please feel free to correct me if I am wrong.

Rev 17:1-18:1

- 1 And there came one of the seven angels which had the seven vials, and talked with me, saying unto me, Come here; I will show unto thee the judgment of the great whore that sits upon many waters:
 - 2 With whom the kings of the earth have committed fornication, and the inhabitants of the earth have been made drunk with the wine of her fornication.
- 3 So he carried me away in the spirit into the wilderness: and I saw a woman sit upon a scarlet coloured beast, full of names of blasphemy, having seven heads and ten horns.
- 4 And the woman was arrayed in purple and scarlet colour, and decked with gold and precious stones and pearls, having a golden cup in her hand full of abominations and filthiness of her fornication:

Who was the adulteress 'bride' of God in the OT? Rome or Jerusalem?

- 5 And upon her forehead was a name written, MYSTERY, BABYLON THE GREAT, THE MOTHER OF HARLOTS AND ABOMINATIONS OF THE EARTH.
- 6 And I saw the woman drunken with the blood of the saints, and with the blood of the martyrs of Jesus: and when I saw her, I wondered with great admiration. Who, but Jerusalem, was drunk with the blood of saints and prophets and martyrs in the time when John wrote this letter? Indeed, it was Jerusalem ALONE who slew the prophets!

Acts 7:52

- 52 Which of the prophets have not your fathers persecuted? and they (Jews) have slain them which showed before of the coming of the Just One; of whom ye have been now the betrayers and murderers: Also, the Bible tells us that the prophets all died in Jerusalem. As well, after 70AD, there were no prophets and apostles anymore. Papal Rome could not possibly be the city as it did not exist until almost 4 centuries into the future!!.
- 7 And the angel said unto me, Why did you marvel? I will tell thee the mystery of the woman, and of the beast that carried her, which has the seven heads and ten horns.
- 8 The beast that you saw was, and is not; and shall ascend out of the bottomless pit, and go into perdition: and they that dwell on the earth shall wonder, whose names were not written in the book of life from the foundation of the world, when they behold the beast that was, and is not, and yet is.
- 9 And here is the mind which has wisdom. The seven heads are seven mountains, on which the woman sits
 - 10 And there are seven kings: five are fallen, and one is, and the other is not yet come; and when he comes, he must continue a short space.
- 11 And the beast that was, and is not, even he is the eighth, and is of the seven, and goes into perdition.
- 12 And the ten horns which you saw are ten kings, which have received no kingdom as yet; but receive

power as kings one hour with the beast.

- 13 These have one mind, and shall give their power and strength unto the beast.
- 14 These shall make war with the Lamb, and the Lamb shall overcome them: for he is Lord of lords, and King of kings: and they that are with him are called, and chosen, and faithful.
- 15 And he said unto me, The waters which you saw, where the whore sits, are peoples, and multitudes, and nations, and tongues.
 - 16 And the ten horns which thou saw upon the beast, these shall hate the whore, and shall make her desolate and naked, and shall eat her flesh, and burn her with fire.
- 17 For God has put in their hearts to fulfill his will, and to agree, and give their kingdom unto the beast, until the words of God shall be fulfilled.
 - 18 And the woman which you saw is that great city, which reigns over the kings of the earth.

Rev 11:8

8 And their dead bodies shall lie in the street of the great city, which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt, where also our Lord was crucified. *This has to be Jerusalem!*

Rev 18:18-19

18 And cried when they saw the smoke of her burning, saying, What city is like unto this great city?

19 And they cast dust on their heads, and cried, weeping and wailing, saying, Alas, alas, that great city, wherein were made rich all that had ships in the sea by reason of her costliness! for in one hour is she made desolate. This, also, must be Jerusalem because it was only a Jewish custom to cast dust on their heads!

Rev 18:21-24

- 21 And a mighty angel took up a stone like a great millstone, and cast it into the sea, saying, Thus with violence shall that great city Babylon be thrown down, and shall be found no more at all.
- 22 And the voice of harpers, and musicians, and of pipers, and trumpeters, shall be heard no more at all in thee; and no craftsman, of whatsoever craft he be, shall be found any more in thee; and the sound of a millstone shall be heard no more at all in thee;
- 23 And the light of a candle shall shine no more at all in thee; and the voice of the bridegroom and of the bride shall be heard no more at all in thee: for thy merchants were the great men of the earth; for by thy sorceries were all nations deceived.
- 24 And in her was found the blood of *prophets*, *and of saints*, and of all that were slain upon the earth (*land or country*).

Again, who killed the prophets?

Proof positive that Jerusalem is that 'great city Babylon' for in what other country or nation is found the 'blood of the prophets, saints, and ALL that were slain upon the earth (or more correctly) upon the land!

When you read Revelation and the very first verse tells you that the things written therein were to 'happen shortly' that puts the cap on it, for Papal Rome was not something that was to happen 'shortly', but the destruction of Jerusalem (Sodom, Egypt, Babylon) was--70AD!
